- 2 Plant 3 pollinator-friendly flowers: lavender, sunflower, marigold, aloe, indigenous wildflowers.
- 3 Water and care for them.
- 4 Photograph the patch every month.
- 5 Watch for visits from bees, butterflies, birds.
- 6 You are now actively WEAVING the Web of Life. ■■
